

§694.6 Who may provide GEAR UP services to students attending private schools?

Paragraph (b) Options

Option 1:

(b) In providing GEAR UP services to students attending private schools, the employee, individual, association, agency, or organization must be independent of the private school that the students attend, and of any ~~religious-other~~ organization affiliated with the school, and that employment or contract must be under the control and supervision of the public agency.

Option 2:

In providing GEAR UP services to students attending private schools, the employee, individual, association, agency, or organization must be independent of the private school that the students attend, ~~and of any other organization affiliated with the school,~~ and that employment or contract must be under the control and supervision of the public agency.

Option 3

(b) In providing GEAR UP services to students attending private schools, the employee, individual, association, agency, or organization ~~cannot be simultaneously employed by~~ must be independent of the private school that the students attend, ~~and or~~ of any religious organization affiliated with the school (to perform the GEAR UP services), and that employment or contract must be under the control and supervision of the public agency.

Option 4

(b) ~~When~~ in providing GEAR UP services to students attending private schools, the employee, individual, association, agency, or organization must be employed or contracted independently of the private school that the students attend, and of any religious organization affiliated with the school, and that employment or contract must be under the control and supervision of the public agency.

Option 5

(b) ~~When~~ in providing GEAR UP services to students attending private schools, the employee, individual, association, agency, or organization must be employed or contracted independently of the private school that the students attend, ~~and of any religious organization affiliated with the school,~~ and that employment or contract must be under the control and supervision of the public agency.
