Gainful Employment Informational Rate Data Description

The unit of analysis for the informational rate data file is the unique combination of opeid6, credlev, and cipcode. The universe of programs includes programs with at least one completer reported to IPEDS in 2014-15 and/or 2015-16 and programs with reported earnings data from the IRS with at least 30 reported individuals in the cohort. The universe of programs excludes those in foreign institutions and programs in institutions that are not currently operating.
