Dear Mr. Butler:

As a condition of accepting Education Job Funds, I understand Hawaii must maintain a fiscal effort for education for State fiscal year (FY) 2011 in one of four ways:

1. Maintain FY 2011 dollar levels of support at levels that are not less than FY 2009 levels;
2. Maintain FY 2011 percentages of support at percentages that are not less than FY 2010 percentages;
3. Maintain FY 2011 dollar levels of support at levels that are not less than FY 2006 levels; or
4. Maintain FY 2011 percentages of support at percentages that are not less than FY 2006 percentages.

Hawaii has selected option three and will maintain State FY 2011 dollar levels of support at levels that are not less than State FY 2006; and for State FY 2011 will maintain support for public institutions of higher education (IHEs) (not including support for capital projects or for research and development or tuition and fees paid by students) at not less than the level of such support for State FY 2006.
