FY 2009 EMHE GPRA Reporting Plan

MEASURE: The percentage of EMHE grantees that demonstrate a 50% increase at the end of the project period in the number of course completions by their higher education institution personnel in key National Incident Management System (NIMS) courses compared to the number of such courses completed at the start of the grant project period.

This measure asks for the percentage of grantees with a 50% increase for all EMHE program grant sites for FY 2009.

- The percent increase in NIMS course completions by each grantee site will be reported to two decimal places.
- Percentage of grantees with an increase of 50% or more will be reported as the GPRA measure.
- There will be a note for consortium projects, listing the participating IHEs.
- If the grantee did not provide a baseline number of hazards, it will be designated "No Baseline Provided"
- If the grantee did not provide interpretable data, it will be designated "invalid data."
- If the grantee did not provide a final report, project status charts, or the exact GPRA measure it will be designated "Not Reported."
- If the grantee is still within an active performance period it will be designated "Performance Period ends MM/DD/YYYY."
- If the grantee is still within an active performance period or the final report is not yet due it will be designated "Data not yet due to ED."

The following information will also be provided:

• Total number of sites in 2009 EMHE cohort	26
• Sites providing comparable data across two time periods	21
• Sites without comparable data across two time periods	5
• Response rate (percentage of cohort with data that permits assessment of progress toward measure)	81%
• Percentage of sites achieving progress for this measure (Number achieving progress divided by sites providing comparable data.	95%

Assumptions/Additional Information

Measure covers eighteen months of grant activity (or greater if granted a no-cost extension). A site is counted as having achieved progress toward increasing NIMS course completions if there is 50% or greater increase between the baseline number of course completions and 2010/2011 (end of performance period).

Grantees were given the following guidance regarding employee attrition: Do not include employees who no longer work for your institution in your GPRA calculation. Do not include employees who did not have the opportunity to complete the EMHE project's entire NIMS training program.

Sites were not required to collect baseline data before their applications were submitted or grants were awarded.
