The U.S. Department of Education (Department) is pleased to advise you that the subject property in Bryson City, North Carolina has been determined surplus to the needs of the federal government and may be available for acquisition by eligible educational organizations at substantial Public Benefit Allowance discount.

The property is located on the south side of Main Street within the Central Business District (CBD) and consists of approximately 1.3 acres improved with one three-story building of approximately 34,156 GSF. The structure is constructed of reinforced cast concrete and foundation with the exterior being defined by painted concrete columns that surround vertical brick panels. The building was erected in 1962 as a Post Office and courthouse. The building is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The U.S. Department of Education (Department) has authority under the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended, to award surplus federal real estate to educational institutions as grants-in-aid at Public Benefit Allowance discounts ranging from 40 to 100 percent off the current fair market value of property in return for an organization's contractual commitment to utilize the land and buildings for approved education programs. Please be advised that this property has been determined to be suitable for homeless use under the Stewart B. McKinney Vento Homeless Assistance Act. Any homeless interests that are received by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services will receive priority over other uses, including education.
