GAANN Fellowship Program

▲ *Is the GAANN Program the right fit for your institution?*

Key components of the program:

- 1) Eligible students must demonstrate financial need.*
- 2) One- year supervisory teaching requirement.*
- 3) Evaluation.*



GAANN Fellowships Program

What's New?:

- ▶ *Institutions can only make fellowship awards to individuals who plan to pursue the highest possible graduate degree available in their course of study at the institution.*
- ▶ *New grantees are now required to submit an additional final performance report to provide data on the academic and employment status for all fellows--two years after the grant has expired.*
- ▶ *Applications must be submitted electronically using e-Application.*
- ▶ *The page limit for Interdisciplinary applications is now 40 pages maximum.*

- ✦ *Closing Date – December*
- ✦ *Competition –January /February*
- ✦ *Awards Made – Early June*
