Project Abstract

The Keweenaw Bay Ojibwa Community College (KBOCC), located in L'Anse, Michigan, is a rural two-year college chartered by the Keweenaw Bay Indian Community in 1975. The College's mission is to provide postsecondary education rich in Ojibwa culture, tradition and beliefs that support life-long learning. The Keweenaw Bay Ojibwa Community College is seeking funding to strengthen institutional systems to increase the College's capacity through the following main objectives:

- 1) strengthen funds management through enhanced capacity in the Office of Sponsored Programs;
- 2) enhance assessment of student learning and institution effectiveness;
- 3) increase and enhance student services programs; and
- 4) to build capacity for faculty, staff, and Board of Regents through professional development trainings.
