**Project Name:** Napa Valley Unified School District Magnet Schools Assistance Program

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**Number of Schools Served:** 4

**Number of Students Served:** 1,516

**Year 1 Funding:** \$2,591,864

The Napa Valley Unified School District (NVUSD) covers a wide geographic area in California's Napa Valley. The district has experienced rapidly changing demographics over the past decade as an increasing number of low-income families have made the city of Napa their permanent home. These changing demographics have created racial group isolation in NVUSD.

Magnet schools are a critical component of NVUSD's plan to reduce racial group isolation, improve academic achievement, and increase school choice options. The district will create four Magnet Schools Assistance Program-funded magnet schools, each with a corresponding magnet theme, as follows:

Magnet School	Magnet Theme
Alta Heights Elementary School	Mathematics, Art, Science, and Technology
Bel Aire Park Elementary School	International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme
Pueblo Vista Elementary School	Environmental Sciences
Salvador Elementary School	Visual and Performing Arts

With its implementation of the mathematics, art, science, and technology theme, Alta Heights Elementary School will expand its capacity and attract students from lower-performing feeder schools. The International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme theme at Bel Aire Park Elementary School and the environmental sciences theme at Pueblo Vista Elementary School will improve students' academic achievement and reduce racial group isolation at the schools. The visual and performing arts magnet program at Salvador Elementary School will expand opportunities for students from lower-performing schools to attend this higher-performing Title I school.
