

Part C Dispute Resolution Data Notes

2018-19 Reporting Year

American Samoa

- American Samoa has not had any complaints during this reporting year.

Kansas

- Kansas Part C did not adopt Part B procedures.

Kentucky

- There were no due process cases or cases for mediation during the time period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019.

New Jersey

- NJ Part C is cognizant of the significant increase in the number of dispute resolutions for the reporting period 7/1/2018 to 6/30/2019 over previous years. The Part C program underwent a major transition of data and billing vendors which resulted in family confusion and concerns and request for due process regarding their family cost participation costs. Now in its second year of operation, the users of the billing system for the Part C program have made significant progress in understanding the billing procedures and the methods by which to assure family rights regarding their co-pays. For each of the requests for dispute resolution, the program was successful in resolving each of the disputes that were presented.

Oklahoma

- No written, signed complaints, mediation requests or due process complaints were filed during the survey period
