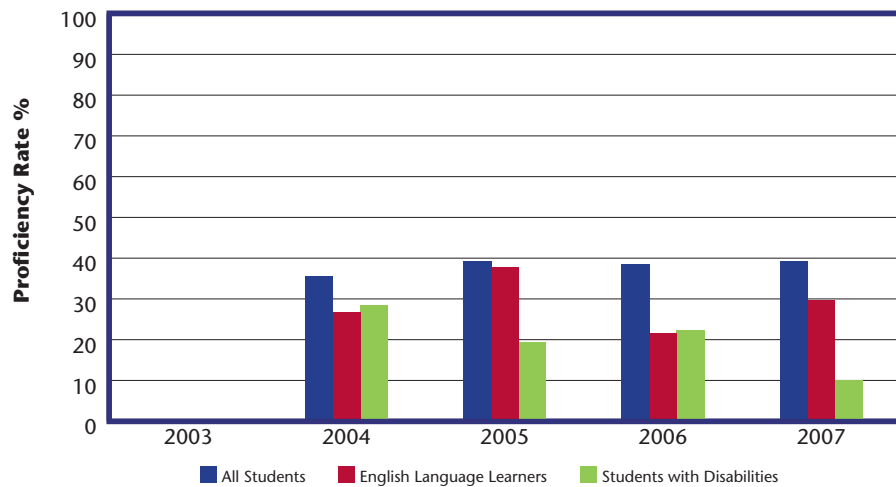

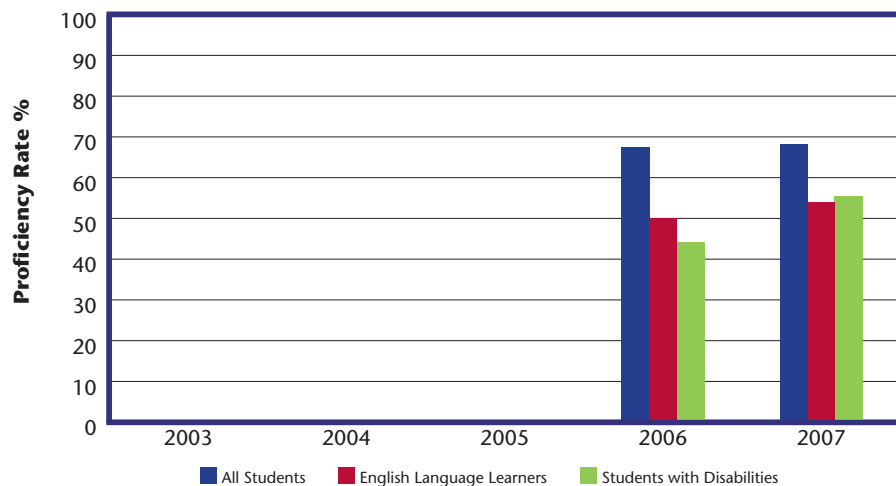

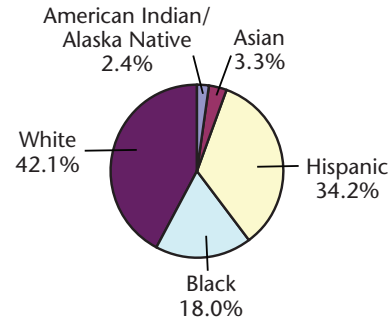

- ❑ By the third and fourth years of Reading First implementation, 1st graders at Reading First schools scored at the national average of the 50th NCE.
- ❑ By the fourth year of Reading First implementation, 2nd graders in Reading First schools scored at the national average.
