The majority of the funding for all 14 IHEs, 97%, went towards the salaries and correlating benefits for personnel in the areas of academic support, administration, instruction, and student support. The remaining funds went towards supplies and service and equipment purchases, 2% and 1%, respectively. In conversations with all of the IHEs, a similar theme arose on the impact that these funds had on their organizations. Without these funds, drastic cost-saving measures would have taken place including significant staff lay-offs in all areas, a considerable increase in fees, tuition, and class sizes, a reduction in student services, elimination of programs and class options, and capping student enrollment. Entry from previous timeframe:

Since 2004, Arizona has added 145,000 additional K-12 students and \$1 billion in increased annual expenses. While the State slashed overall government spending by more than 2.2 billion, additional cuts or revenue streams were needed to balance the budget. While the SFSF funding played a significant role in balancing the State budget in 2009 and 2010 it was not enough to avert a sales tax increase necessary to provide basic support for education in Arizona. VI. Progress in Advancing Education Reform

A. Reducing inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers:

Describe the steps that the State has taken, from October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, to reduce inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers.

Entry from previous timeframe:

Arizona has moved aggressively to reduce inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers. One of the first investments of SFSF-Government Services funds was to Teach for America (TFA). With a strong track record of success, TFA used these funds to expand its program in Arizona, improve the quality of the Arizona education system and meet the objectives of the SFSF program. Using these funds, TFA increased the effectiveness of its teachers who are working to close the achievement gap for more than 20,000 low-income students in pre-K through 12th grade, and bolster its efforts to reach students in high-need subject areas such as math, science, and special education. It has also been able to strengthen its work to develop the leadership of TFA's growing base of 420 alumni as they continue working for educational equity from both inside education and across other sectors. This appropriation came at a critical time for Teach For America in Phoenix. As ASU's Sanford Education Project launched, it was necessary that TFA maintained its current corps size, which drives the capacity and resources available to it to engage in these types of partnerships. Of the 19 recommendations contained in the document the following are relevant to this discussion: *Recommendation 8: Establish the use of educator evaluations to facilitate continuous improvements at all levels of a school; *Recommendation 9: Enhance incentives for alternative pathways; *Recommendation 10: Provide pre-service and new teachers and administrators with meaningful mentorship and education experiences; *Recommendation 11: Provide incentives for highly effective educators to work in struggling schools; and *Recommendation 12: Grow a cadre of turnaround experts at the teacher, principal, and district levels through a turnaround leadership training program that coordinates various leadership training opportunities. Arizona has made progress on each of these recommendations, as well as on the rest of the reform plan.

Recommendation 8 was accomplished by state statute requiring the use of quantitative data in educator evaluations. A framework to guide LEAs in implementing that law was adopted by the State Board of Education in April, 2011. Trainings in rigorous development and implementation of this framework have been conducted through Regional Education Centers, statewide teacher evaluation summits (three have been held to date, with a fourth planned for summer 2012), and statewide participation in WestEd's Southwest Comprehensive Center symposiums. Recommendation 9 has been a key priority of the State Board of Education and was part of the Governor's 2012 legislative agenda. This included key legislation that was signed that allow post-secondary teachers in STEM fields more flexibility to obtain a K-12 teaching certificate. The State Board for Education is also exploring easing the hiring and other personnel processes for schools which receive an A rating on our statewide accountability system.

Recommendation 10 is a more local issue in Arizona. However, the ramp-up of Regional Education Centers has allowed collaboration between two large entities which have Federal TIF grants (Arizona State University and the Maricopa County Education Service Agency), to share best practices in meaningful mentorship and induction – particularly related to the TAP System they are both implementing. Recommendation 11 is also a key priority for the State Board of Education and the Governor's Office. The Governor's Arizona Ready Education Council has created a task force to align education funding with key student achievement priorities. In light of that work, Arizona was selected by the NGA to receive a grant for Policy Academy to collaborate with other states on best practice. The task force is currently exploring whether schools that receive a D or F rating on the state accountability system will be required to partner with A schools on key

areas such as teacher evaluation, alignment to Arizona’s Common Core Standards, and response to intervention programs. Both schools would receive financial incentives to partner. Recommendation 12 requires several interim steps – the first of which is ensuring that teachers are fully trained on Arizona’s Common Core standards. Once that training has achieved statewide depth with fidelity, a cadre of turnaround leaders that are well versed in curricular “change management” can be created. While it was originally anticipated that RTTT funds would provide the resources to implement all of these activities, Arizona received a small amount of funding in Round 3 to support the roll out of the common core and continued development of the data system. The state continues to identify and reprioritize local and federal resources in order to move all 19 recommendations forward. Two elements are of particular note. First, the launch of an education reform website to communicate with Arizonans about critical education issues at www.arizonaready.com. Second, the development of an interactive online education report card to track Arizona’s progress on our four quantitative goals and related indicators at <http://www.arizonaready.com/content/index.html>. These tools assist in communicating with parents, teachers and the public the critical reforms that are taking place in Arizona – many as a result of SFSF funding.
