Entry from previous timeframe:

**Because Iowa has a dedicated penny sales tax exclusively for school district infrastructure, none of this funding was used for construction, modernization, renovation or repair projects. At the same time Iowa was approved to start accessing this funding, Iowa saw a sharp decline in available revenue due to a downturn in the economy. This prompted a decision on the part of the Governor and the legislature to reduce the available state school district formula funding and replace it with ARRA SFSF Education funds. The legislature dedicated funding to school districts using these funds in SFY09, SFY10, and SFY11. Because this ended up as state aid funding replacement and because school budgets were already determined and because 80% of a given school district's funding is personnel, the large majority of these funds, based on information provided in subrecipient reports, was used for staff salaries and benefits. We are estimating 97% of the ARRA SFSF Education funding provided to local school districts was used for this purpose. Also based on subrecipient reports, we can say that roughly 3% of these funds were used for other permissive uses that include, but are not limited to, purchase of instructional materials and professional development activities. Based on the jobs reporting data, this funding saved roughly 4000 staff positions during SFY10. Had this funding not been available in SFYs 09-11, it is likely that a roughly 10% reduction in state funding for schools would have occurred.**

**This update is still accurate. The state allocated the remaining Ed Stabilization funds entirely to K-12 schools for the period covered by this APR. Since schools had less funding in FY11 in this fund compared to FY10, all of this funding went to cover salaries and benefits.**

## **II.B. Uses of Education Stabilization funds by public IHEs**

Provide a concise narrative of how public IHEs in your State have generally used Education Stabilization funds, and the impact that the funds have had on postsecondary education in your State from October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011:

Entry from previous timeframe:

**Regent institutions and community colleges received ARRA-SFSF funds in the amount of \$103,380,000 in FY 2010 only. Eight-four percent of the funding went directly to salaries and benefits. Institutions were instructed to follow ARRA-SFSF guidelines carefully, and to use the fund to avoid a funding cliff as budget plans were made for FY 2011. As the recipients of the bulk of the ARRA-SFSF funds distributed to the Board of Regents (\$80,280,000), the public universities were required, when presenting their FY 2010 budgets at the June 2009 Board of Regents meeting, to show how ARRA funds would be used quarterly to avoid the funding cliff. As Iowa was selected as one of the 16 states and localities for which the Government Accountability Office would detail the use of funds made available in the Act, each institution identified contact persons to work with the Board of Regents business office, state staff, and the GAO. To provide accountability and transparency, Regent institutions worked with state agencies to develop guidelines and databases, as well as setting up internal processes. Among those internal processes, proposals for modernization, renovation, or repair at Regent public universities that spent \$1 million or more were submitted to the Board of Regents for approval. Community colleges in Iowa are responsible directly to the Department of Education and the State Board of Education, they do not have a separate Governing Board. As a result, community colleges followed procedures similar to those established for K-12 school districts in Iowa. They were required to establish discrete accounting lines for each portion of ARRA-SFSF funding, were required to include expenditures in annual financial reporting, and were required to submit quarterly Section 1512 reports. All of the funding at the community college level went to salaries, benefits, and instructional materials.**

Entry from previous timeframe:

**The general answer in every subcategory below is that these funds were used to replace lost state general funds for the purpose designated. All of this funding went to state agencies, local school districts or public IHEs to implement the programs where the state funding was reduced. Local school districts received this money in SFY11 to replace lost state aid formula dollars and are using these funds in the same way as ARRA SFSF Education funds. Community Colleges received funding in SFY10 for instructor supplemental pay. In the public safety subcategory, \$14,000,000 went to the various correctional facilities to continue to employ staff. \$750,000 went to the Department of Public Safety for the same purpose. The funding in public assistance went to Human Services (\$36,581,000) for support of the four Mental Health Institutions and the seven county risk pools for mental health services. An additional \$3,000,000 went to Public Health for the support of county public health facility staff. Transportation received \$5,550,000 for road projects. ### **III.A. & B. Tuition and Fees**

Describe any actions taken by the State to limit increases in tuition and fees imposed by public IHEs for in-State students:

Entry from previous timeframe:

**Eighty-four percent of this funding went to cover staff salaries and benefits during FY10 and FY11. This was replacement of lost state aid, so the funding provided through ARRA-SFSF prevented post-secondary institutions from raising tuition by a similar amount to recoup lost state aid dollars. While there are some other mechanisms to recoup lost state aid dollars, at the time of the state aid reduction, with budgets set, raising tuition was the only real recourse. This ARRA-SFSF funding delayed increases to tuition for all of these institutions. Unfortunately, this funding was provided only in FY10 and with no additional ARRA-SFSF funding made available in FY11, some tuition increases have already occurred to offset this loss of federal funds. In two and a half years, the Regent universities have absorbed over \$118 million in permanent budget reductions to general university funds. Nowhere in the nation was state funding for public higher education cut more in FY 2010 than in Iowa (-21%); the U.S. average was -3.4% . For the public universities, this cut was moderated to -16.4% when funds were restored to meet federal stimulus guidelines, and placed Iowa 45th among the other states in state support for higher education. Despite the material cuts imposed, the Board of Regents held tuition and fees increases to 3.4% in FY 2009, 4.4% in FY 2010, and 6.5% last fall – less than the national average of 6.9%. At that same time, the Regents increased the commitment to student financial aid to record levels to ensure continued access to the public universities for all Iowans regardless of means. In each of the last two fiscal years, Regent universities have exceeded by approximately \$40M the minimum 15% of gross tuition proceeds set aside for student financial aid required under Board Policy Manual Chapter 8.05C. ARRA-SFSF funds were significant in keeping tuition increases low in FY 2010. It is estimated that if the Regents were to have offset state cuts since FY 2009 with tuition, a tuition increase of 23% would have been needed.**

**The above summary is still accurate. Public IHEs received no additional funding from any Stabilization source for the period under review by this APR. The state has subsequently (in the FY13 legislative session) established a tuition relief fund in an attempt to help hold down tuition increases at public IHEs in Iowa.**

These changes have been made as of April 1, 2009. The checklist has already been used for a Title I LEA monitoring visit. 2. Title IIA – Beginning September 1, 2009, any LEA that has not met annual measurable objectives in meeting the HQT challenge for three consecutive years and has failed to make AYP for three years will be required to enter into an agreement on the use of Title IIA funds. Bureau of Planning, Research, and Development and Evaluation Services provide a list that meet both of these criteria and then enter into agreement with SEA and LEA on how LEA is going to achieve 100 percent HQT. 3. Title IIA Monitoring in Site Visits – The Bureau of Accreditation and Improvement Services has worked this monitoring into Equity visits that take place in LEAs each year. Additions to LEA document review process and interview protocols have been made to ensure that poor and minority students are not being taught at a higher rate by inexperienced, unqualified or out-of-state teachers. If this is a compliance issue, the school improvement representative will cite the district and the LEA action plan must reflect solutions.**
