III.A. & B. Tuition and Fees

Describe any actions taken by the State to limit increases in tuition and fees imposed by public IHEs for in-State students:

Entry from previous timeframe:

The State of Michigan, acting through the Michigan Department of Education, required each public IHE to submit a plan detailing the institution's policies and practices that would help Michigan students and their families cope with the costs of undergraduate education in the 2009-10 academic year. Specifically, the State solicited information on tuition restraint policies, tuition rebates, payment deferrals, and financial aid programs, particularly those aimed at families suffering severe hardships. The State also required the submission of administrative pay increase details and policies, as well as tuition policies for years beyond the 2009-10 academic year. Each public IHE reported increased spending on financial aid to students, with many setting up or bolstering programs designed to meet the additional needs of Michigan students whose families suffered unexpected unemployment due to the locally severe effects of the recession. Most universities also decided to temporarily replace spending on an eliminated State scholarship. This additional spending, as well as a reported trend of salary freezes or donations of increases back to the university by senior administrative staff, helped mitigate tuition and fees costs for students. Many IHEs certified to the Michigan Department of Education that without the funding from the State Fiscal Stabilization Fund, steeper tuition increases would have been necessary to balance their budgets. The tuition and fees amounts in the table are based upon estimates.

IV. Tax Increases Averted

Estimate the degree to which State tax increases were averted because of the availability of SFSF funds.

Entry from previous timeframe:

In order to avoid a "funding cliff", the appropriation of the SFSF-ESF Fund was spread over three fiscal years in the school aid budget: \$600 million in FY2009, \$450 million in FY2010 and \$184 million in FY11. In FY2010, the former Governor proposed a tax restructuring reform that would have closed the remaining projected funding gap in the school aid budget; however, it did not pass the Legislature. Instead, an overall per pupil reduction was implemented to balance the school aid budget. Therefore, it is assumed that if the federal SFSF funds were not available, the school aid budget would have been reduced in fiscal year 2009 by approximately 1/3 of the total available SFSF-ESF funding amount (\$400 million) and that cut would have been maintained in FY2010 and FY2011. In 2009, all of the nearly \$290 million of SFSF-GSF funding was appropriated to fund departments of Corrections and State Police, with a \$2 million set-aside for supporting the Economic Recovery Office. In FY2010, \$68 million of the SFSF-ESF was appropriated to higher education. Again, because the Legislature did not pass the former Governor's proposed tax restructuring reform in FY2010, it is assumed that State budgets would have been reduced further in FY2009 and FY 2010 by the amounts of the SFSF funding used in those years. State budgets with the most general fund in them would have received the largest reductions. Those budgets are for the departments of Community Health, Corrections, Human Services and State Police and for higher education. Without the SFSF funding, there would have been no need for the Economic Recovery Office.

Please update for the new timeframe:

For FY2011, the school aid budget included the final installment of SFSF-ESF funding in the amount of \$184 million. At the time the FY2011 budget was enacted, in order to keep spending in line with available revenues, the \$170 per-pupil reduction from FY2010 was maintained in FY2011. Actual state revenues for FY2011, finalized after the fiscal year was complete, were higher than estimated; and in response, the Michigan Legislature earmarked a portion of the ending FY2011 fund balance for distribution in FY2012. A total of \$442 million was appropriated in the FY2012 school aid budget (PA 62 of 2011), earmarked from a portion of the FY2011 ending fund balance for specific K-12 education purposes (388.1622f, 388.1747a, 388.1747b).

V. Jobs Saved or Created

VI. Progress in Advancing Education Reform

A. Reducing inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers:

Describe the steps that the State has taken, from October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, to reduce inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers.

Entry from previous timeframe:

Based on December 2009 data, Michigan had approximately 219,064 core subject area classes. Statewide, 99.57% of the teachers in those classes were Highly Qualified. In Michigan's high poverty and high minority schools, 99.19% of the core academic teachers were Highly Qualified. The difference in the distribution of Highly Qualified teachers statewide versus high poverty/high minority schools is 0.38%, which is a decrease from previous years. Michigan publicly reports the equitable distribution data annually. The MDE and the Office of Professional Preparation Services continues to provide support to schools in order to better understand the Highly Qualified requirements and reduce any inequities in the distribution of Highly Qualified teachers in all schools, particularly the high need schools. The Michigan Technical Assistance Project (MiTAP) is in its fourth year, having visited all schools with core academic teachers, revisiting those that need additional assistance or identified as high need, and randomly revisiting others to ensure compliance with the NCLB. MiTAP is staffed by seven technical assistance providers that make onsite visits to schools, review master schedules, teacher credentials and verify Highly Qualified status. Schools are advised regarding equitable distribution. Schools with non-Highly Qualified teachers are required to submit an action plan to reach the 100% Highly Qualified requirement. Technical assistance providers submit a list of non-Highly Qualified teachers to the Office of Education Improvement and Innovation for Title I restrictions or recommendation that Title II funds be used to assist teachers in becoming Highly Qualified. This project has been beneficial to the State in developing a better understanding of the needs of school for staffing and in reducing any inequities Michigan may have.

Please update for the new timeframe:

Utilizing December 2010 data, Michigan had approximately 231,538 core subject area classes. Statewide, 99.7% of the teachers in those classes were Highly Qualified. In Michigan's high poverty and high minority schools, 99.7% of the core academic teachers were Highly Qualified. There is no difference in the distribution of Highly Qualified teachers statewide versus high poverty/high minority schools. MDE and the Office of Professional Preparation Services continues to provide support to schools in order to better understand the Highly Qualified requirements and reduce any inequities in the distribution of Highly Qualified teachers in all schools, particularly the high need schools and focusing on those with less than 100% of their courses taught by Highly Qualified teachers. The Michigan Technical Assistance Project (MiTAP) is in its fifth year, revisiting those that need additional assistance or identified as high need, and randomly revisiting others to ensure compliance with the NCLB.
