Note, however, that the Ohio legislature has historically placed limitations on the Board of Trustees ability to increase tuition and fees for in-state, undergraduate students as part of the legislation guiding the biennial operating bill. Furthermore, the legislatively imposed tuition limitations are established, in part, by the level of state support appropriated to public institutions of higher education. In FY 2010 and FY 2011, based on the combined state general revenue funds and State Fiscal Stabilization Funds appropriated to Ohio's public institutions, IHEs were required to limit tuition and fee increases for in-state, undergraduate students to no more than 3.5% each year.**

#### VI. Progress in Advancing Education Reform

##### A. Reducing inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers:

Describe the steps that the State has taken, from October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2011, to reduce inequities in the distribution of highly qualified teachers.

Entry from previous timeframe:

**The Office of Educator Equity (OEE) at the Ohio Department of Education provides technical assistance to LEAs with alarming Highly Qualified Teacher data. OEE collaborates with the LEA's Federal Programs Coordinator and HR Director to conduct a review and analysis of teachers who are teaching core academic subjects in which they are not highly qualified, reviews and/or refines high quality professional development and equity plans to ensure that the teacher is making adequate progress in becoming HQT as quickly as possible, and engages in a series of work with the data collection and reporting staff to ensure accurate HQT data submissions. As a result of these and other differentiated supports based on the equity data of the LEAs, the State's HQT percentage continues to increase. This year Ohio's HQT percentage is 99.3%. OEE reports annually its progress on achieving Equitable Distribution of HQT via the Highly Qualified Teacher Longitudinal Data webpage: <http://www.ode.state.oh.us/GD/Templates/Pages/ODE/ODEDetail.aspx?page=3&TopicRelationID=850&ContentID=84856&Content=86274> The State has also developed its online Teacher and Principal Evaluation Survey (survey is aligned to SFSF data indicators) which will be launched and available for LEAs to complete and submit virtually starting Spring 2011. The State will develop and publish a summative report based on the survey results. In addition, the State has developed the RttT Scope of Work which outlines the work in its RttT grant. For Year 1, the Equity work will involve developing high quality professional development on best practices to manage educator talent (creating an integrated and aligned recruitment, hiring, retention, professional development, teacher leadership, performance management system), assessing and improving teaching and learning conditions in schools, conducting an Equitable Distribution of Highly Effective and Effective Educators (EDHE) analysis, and developing equity plans based on results of the analysis.**

Please update for the new timeframe:

**For Year 2, the Equity work involves assessing teaching and learning conditions in schools (TELL Ohio). This work entails analysis of survey results and the design of customized high quality professional development based on the analysis of the survey results that can inform and possibly lead to revisions in improvement plans for participating LEAs. (<http://www.tellohio.org/>) The Equity work has provided an Equitable Distribution of Highly Effective Teachers (EDHEE) analysis tool and piloted the tool in LEAs. (<http://education.ohio.gov/GD/Templates/Pages/ODE/ODEDetail.aspx?page=3&TopicRelationID=1451&ContentID=26037&Content=123593>) The Equity work provided a high quality on-line tool for Managing Educator Talent—METworksSM in Ohio, which presents research-based components and strategies to assist LEAs in creating systemic, comprehensive and aligned approaches to recruiting, retaining and developing effective teachers and principals for all students.
