(a) Although the term "college-ready" does not appear in the 2009–10 Educational Opportunity Centers Annual Performance Report, TRIO uses the term "college-ready" in order to maintain continuity with reports for previous years. However, TRIO cautions that the meaning of "college-ready" has changed somewhat. In 2005–06 and previous years, the APR used the term "college-ready" to refer to a specific group of participants defined in the instructions who formed the denominator for the enrollment measure: high school graduates or equivalents and high school seniors, with certain participants excluded by grantees who believed that those individuals did not possess the skills necessary to succeed in postsecondary education. Beginning in 2006–07, the term "college-ready" did not appear in the APR. Instead, for the denominator the program specified groups of participants that aligned with the enrollment objective established for the 2006 grant competition: adults without HS diploma or equivalency credentials (19 years or older) enrolled in a continuing education program at an academic level equivalent to a high school senior (APR Section III, item A2), high school graduates or high school equivalency graduates not already enrolled in a postsecondary school (III.A3), postsecondary dropouts (III.A4), potential postsecondary transfers (III.A6), high school seniors (III.B2), and participants not older than 18 years enrolled in an alternative education program at an academic level equivalent to a high school senior (III.B4).

(b) The rate of low-income, potential first-generation college students served was calculated by dividing the number of program participants who were *both* low-income *and* potential first-generation college students (APR Section II, item B1) by the total number of participants served by that project (II.A3), and multiplying by 100.
