The Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) acknowledges your electronic submission via the RSA Web site of the fiscal year (FY) 2013 State Plan for the Title I Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Services Program and Supplement for the Title VI-B Supported Employment (SE) Services Program in the form of a preprint of affirmative assurances and required attachments on behalf of the Illinois Division of Rehabilitation Services (IDRS) in compliance with Sections 101(a) and 625 of the *Rehabilitation Act of 1973*, as amended (the act).
