The Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) acknowledges your submission via RSA's Web site of the fiscal year (FY) 2013 State Plan for the Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) Services Program and Supplement for the Supported Employment (SE) Services Program in the form of a preprint of affirmative assurances and required attachments on behalf of the Washington Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (WDVR) in compliance with Sections 101(a) and 625 of the *Rehabilitation Act of 1973*, as amended (the act).
